### Key Qualifications:

Professor Francisco is qualified in demography (Ph. D-1997, ANU-Canberra and MA-1989, ANU-Canberra, Australia) and economics (Bachelor's degree/Licenciatura-1987 and UEM-Maputo, undergraduate degree, BA-1983), and specializes on development economic and demographic issues. He joined the UEM in March 1981 and ever since has been involved in teaching at the university level e Maputo. In 1985 he became lecturer and member of the permanent staff of the Faculty of Economics at the University Eduardo Mondlane (FE-UEM) . In July 1992 he became Senior Lecturer of the FE-UEM; in September 2017 he became the first Full Professor at the Economics Faculty (UEM) and is lecturing Development Economics and Research Seminars, two subjects that are part of the Economics Course at the FE-UEM. Regarding specifically research, Professor Francisco's activity started in the middle of 1980s; since then he has gained experience and undertook managerial responsibilities as team leader, senior consultant, Director and Co-Director of several interdisciplinary research projects dealing with socio-economic and demographic issues. Since 2007 he has been working as one of the Research Directors of the Institute of Social and Economic Studies (IESE), an autonomous, not-for-profit Mozambican organization, structured as an association, and dedicated to social and economic scientific research ([www.iese.ac.mz](http://www.iese.ac.mz)). The following relevant examples illustrate his experience and intellectual achievements:

1. Following the completion of his master's thesis in economics Professor Francisco was invited by Dr. Mário Machungo, former Prime Minister and Minister for Planning of the Mozambican Government, to lead an independent research team. The research was part of a program of collaboration between the Government and the World Bank concerning the impact of the economic reforms; its completion constituted one of the conditions for the release of the Second Rehabilitation Credit to Mozambique by the World Bank.
2. In 1990, after his MA in Demography, Professor Francisco was invited to integrate a consulting team headed by Professor John Bruce, the Director of Land Tenure Center at the University of Wisconsin-

Madison. The consultancy prepared a plan for a long-term technical assistance and designed an applied research project on divestiture of state farms in Mozambique, which is still in progress.

3. In January 1991 Professor Francisco became Co-Director and principal investigator in the 'Peri-Urban Research Project in Maputo', a project carried out in various stages until March 1993. The research was financed by the USAID and involved the participation of three US universities.
4. In 1998 Professor Francisco became the principal author e coordinator of the first *National Human Development Report 1998* in Mozambique. The success of this publication has led Dr. Emmanuel Dierckx de Casterlé, the UNDP Resident Representative in Mozambique, to invite Professor Francisco to be, as he put it in a letter dated January 18, 1999, "our principal technical architect of our future national reports". Following this invitation, Professor Francisco coordinated the preparation of the *National Human Development Report 1999*, which was published in June 2000.
5. In 1999 Professor Francisco outlined and wrote up the final draft of the National Population Policy, which was approved by Mozambican Government in April 1999. Subsequent to the approval of this national population policy, Professor Francisco worked until the middle of 2001 as a national technical expert and policy advisor next to the Population Technical Cabinet and the Ministry of Planning and Finance, through the United Nations Found for Population (UNFPA) Population and Development Strategies Sub-Programme Central of the 5<sup>th</sup> Country Programme for Mozambique (1998-2001) at the Ministry of Planning and Finance (see details below).
6. Between May 2002 and 2005 Professor Francisco was the Director of the ETC International in Mozambique. The ETC UK was a member of the ETC International, which is a not-for-profit organization that focuses on capacity building in developing countries by working through local offices and local consultants. He undertook several research and feasibility projects for the Maputo, Beira, Nacala and Zambezy Development Corridors, together CESO-Mozambique and the CSIR-South Africa.
7. In 2005-06 Professor Francisco was the Head of the technical team created by the National Directorate for Promotion of Rural Development, with support from the United Nations Program for Development (UNDP / UNCDF) to elaborate the Rural Development Strategy (EDR). The EDR was approved by the Council of Ministers on 11 September 2007.
8. In 2007, together with other senior university researchers, Professor Francisco co-founded the Institute of Social and Economic Studies (IESE), an autonomous, not-for-profit Mozambican organisation, structured as an association, and dedicated to social and economic scientific research. Since September 2007 Professor Francisco has been one of the IESE's Research Directors. Between 2007 and October 2019 he coordinates the Research Group on Poverty, Population and Social Protection,
